Neighborhood Health Visitors is a network of trained Albion community residents dedicated to connecting Albion residents with county health resources.

The goal of this program is for Albion residents to have 100% access to health care with 0% disparities. (Complete equality for everyone.)

Neighborhood Health Visitors will act as community health advocates by giving a voice to the needs of Albion residents.

Services provided by Neighborhood Health Visitors

- Assistance in enrolling in medical and prescription programs
- Medical service referrals
- Free digital thermometer & smoke detector with a 10-year battery

Albion Community Health Resources

Call 211 is a helpline that can provide referrals for emergency financial assistance for food, housing, medical care, legal aid, transportation and much more. Dial: 2-1-1

Oaklawn Hospital provides lab and diagnostic x-ray services with a physician's referral at 115 Market Place. Physical rehabilitation services are provided by Oaklawn Physical Rehabilitation Center at 300 B Drive North.

Calhoun County Dept of Public Health offers services for immunization, family planning, HIV/AIDS testing and the WIC Nutrition Program.

Fountain Clinic serves people with no insurance and who cannot afford needed medical care. The clinic provides physician services, dental services, diagnostic testing and medications.

Community area physicians each provide various medical services. Many also have privileges at Oaklawn Hospital and many are accepting new patients.

Calhoun County Senior Millage Services provides medical, dental and prescription assistance services for low income seniors. The program also assists seniors with legal services, food, and transportation.

Tendercare is a geriatric rehabilitation facility with inpatient and outpatient services such as physical, speech and occupational therapy.
