Enjoy the climbing mural, admire the art, or get more physical. A great place for birthday parties, or to entertain kids and get out of the house.

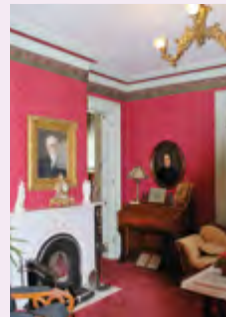

Gardner House Museum

The museum is open to the public by appointment and on Saturday and Sunday from 2-4 p.m. May through September.



The rooms of the museum have been developed to represent a typical dwelling of the 1875-1900 period. Each room contains numerous artifacts and furniture that were once part of area homes.

Three rooms on the second floor contain local history displays which are changed annually by the Albion Historical Society and other volunteers.



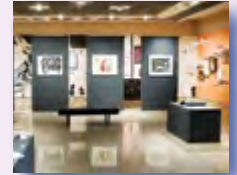
